Matters Arising

RG said she will contact the solicitor about Lease extensions soon. She said she will soon write a newsletter inviting residents to the garden party.

Freshwater Buildings Insurance

RG said Freshwater had given her a photocopy of the freeholder's buildings insurance policy. The document covers:

- A) Buildings
- B) Property owners liability

There were some questions regarding the policy. Asked whether fixtures and fittings are covered, RG replied that kitchen and bathroom fixtures and fittings are covered by the freeholder's insurance, but carpets are the leaseholder's responsibility. Asked who is responsible for pipe work, RG replied that within the flat is the leaseholder's responsibility, outside the flat is the freeholder's.

RG said that Freshwater recommend leaseholders take out an insurance policy designed for leaseholders. Those sub-letting their flats should get appropriate insurance for that purpose.
